IN RE: SB1282 by Duncan (Relating to deadlines for proposals for adoption by certain districts or authorities of desired future conditions of relevant aquifers.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 36 of the Water Code to provide that a groundwater conservation district is not required to adopt a proposal of desired future conditions before September 1, 2016, regardless of the date on which a proposal may have been voted on before September 1, 2013.

According to the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board, no fiscal impact is anticipated.
