Fiscal Analysis

The bill would require the Texas Education Agency (TEA) to conduct a comprehensive review of public school weights, allotments, and adjustments under the public school finance system. The TEA could contract with consultants if necessary. The Legislative Budget Board, the comptroller,

the state auditor, and any other state agency, official, or personnel would be required to cooperate with the TEA in conducting the review. The agency would be required to provide a report by December 1, 2014 of the findings of the review and would be required to include recommendations for updated weights, allotments and adjustments and any other statutory changes considered appropriate by the TEA.

Methodology

Based on the analysis of TEA, the agency would likely contract with national experts on school finance to complete the study at an estimated cost of \$1,000,000.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
