HB 372 Deshotel
Relating to establishing the Workplace Fraud Prevention Act; providing penalties.

HB 667 Martinez, "Mando"
Relating to an unlawful employment practice for an employer whose leave policy does not permit an employee to use leave to care for the employee's foster child.

HB 731 Raymond | et al.
Relating to rest breaks for employees of certain contractors with a governmental entity; providing an administrative penalty.

HB 741 Walle | et al.
Relating to the right of a public employee to breast-feed, or to express breast milk for, the employee's child in the workplace.

HB 1087 Giddings
Relating to the authority of a parent or legal guardian to establish a consumer file for a child or adult ward and act on the child's or adult ward's behalf with a consumer reporting agency.

HB 1369 McClendon
Relating to the ability of a nonexempt employee to participate in certain academic, extracurricular, and developmental activities of the employee's child.

HB 1706 Farrar
Relating to the promotion of breast-feeding and the prohibition against interference with or restriction of the right to breast-feed; providing a private cause of action for denial of this right.

HB 1955 Thompson, Senfronia
Relating to the employment of domestic workers and hotel workers; providing an administrative penalty.
