Relating to the penalty for causing certain assaultive physical contact with a child.

HB 1063 Hernandez Luna | et al.
Relating to the creation of DNA records for the DNA database system.

HB 1284 Johnson
Relating to the offense of making or causing a false alarm or report involving a public or private institution of higher education.

HB 1322 Fletcher
Relating to the sealing of applications and orders for the installation and use of mobile tracking devices in certain law enforcement investigations.

HB 1344 Canales
Relating to the expunction of arrest records and files relating to certain nonviolent offenses.

HB 1790 Longoria
Relating to certain procedures for defendants who successfully complete a period of state jail felony community supervision.

HB 2441 Parker
Relating to directed verdicts.

HJR 39 Burkett
Proposing a constitutional amendment denying bail to certain persons charged with a violent or sexual offense after having been previously convicted of a violent or sexual offense.
