Relating to certain conditions imposed on defendants convicted of an offense of graffiti or juveniles adjudicated as having engaged in conduct involving graffiti.

Relating to the value of personal property that is exempt from seizure to pay a crime victim under an order of restitution.

Relating to the establishment of a procedure for providing incentives for or imposing intermediate sanctions on a person who violates certain conditions of community supervision.

Relating to the prosecution of certain offenses committed against a person in custody.

Relating to the procedures applicable to state jail felony community supervision and to the punishment prescribed for certain state jail felonies.

Relating to the disclosure of exculpatory evidence by a prosecutor in a criminal case.

Relating to the failure to report a missing child or the death of a child; providing penalties.

Relating to delivery of a controlled substance; providing a penalty.
