Relating to coverage of certain eating disorders as serious mental illnesses under certain group health benefit plans.

Relating to first-party indemnity coverage purchased by insurance purchasing groups.

Relating to the payment of insured losses of the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association and funding of the catastrophe reserve trust fund.
