Relating to a moratorium on administering assessment instruments to public school students under the public school accountability system.

HB 274 Alvarado
Relating to reporting requirements applicable to school districts that obtain exceptions from class size limits.

HB 599 Lozano
Relating to educator retention at certain public schools.

HB 904 González, Mary
Relating to a requirement for school districts to report class size to the Texas Education Agency.

HB 921 Alonzo
Relating to establishing the Texas State Seal of Bilingualism and Biliteracy for recognition of high school graduates who attain a high level of proficiency in both English and another language.

HB 1374 Dutton | et al.
Relating to equal opportunity for access by home-schooled students to University Interscholastic League sponsored activities; authorizing a fee.

HB 1415 Schaefer | et al.
Relating to the issuance of school district teaching permits to persons who teach only career and technology education classes.

HB 1525 Krause | et al.
Relating to prohibiting the board of trustees of an independent school district from exercising disparate treatment in allowing access to school campuses during non-instructional time based on the religious nature of an organization.

Relating to funding under the Foundation School Program for a school district that offers insurance benefits to a person who is not a dependent of a district employee.

Relating to the establishment of the recovery school district.

Relating to the determination of certain exemptions from the administration of state assessment instruments to public school students and to the consideration of the performance of certain students on state assessment instruments.

Relating to alternative assessment of certain public school students under the public school accountability system.

HB 2104 Dutton
Relating to charter schools and accurately accounting for workforce development statistics.

HB 2182 Flynn
Relating to the required completion date of a report concerning an initial evaluation of a student for purposes of special education services.

HB 2542 Gutierrez
Relating to a study comparing the effects on school district consolidation for Bexar County.

HB 2610 Pitts
Relating to the issuance of interest-bearing time warrants and certain notes by school districts.

HB 2662 Farney
Relating to requiring a personal financial literacy credit for graduation under the recommended and advanced high school programs.

HB 2666 Taylor, Van
Relating to the first day of the school year for public schools.

HB 2824 Ratliff | et al.
Relating to the Texas High Performance Schools Consortium.

HB 2983 Dutton
Relating to the continuation and functions of the Texas Education Agency and to the abolition of the State Board for Educator Certification and the transfer of its functions to the Texas Education Agency; changing the amounts of certain fees.

Relating to the requirements for obtaining a health science technology education teaching certificate and to the scope of courses a person may teach holding a technology applications teaching certificate.
