Relating to the recovery of uniform statewide accounting project costs from state agencies and vendors.

Relating to authorizing certain real property transactions involving the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas.

Relating to the planning and contracting process for certain state agencies and state property; authorizing fees.

Proposing a constitutional amendment relating to a person's freedom of religion.

HJR 150 Hilderbran
Proposing a constitutional amendment to require a person to be a resident of this state for five years preceding the person's election to the Texas House of Representatives.
