HB 294 Rodriguez, Eddie  
Relating to the exemption from ad valorem taxation of certain property owned by a charitable organization and used in providing housing and related services to certain homeless individuals.

HB 1133 Otto  
Relating to a sales and use tax exemption for tangible personal property used to provide cable television service, Internet access service, or telecommunications services and to the exclusion of that property in certain economic development agreements.

HB 1712 Lozano  
Relating to exemptions from property taxation and sales and use taxation for certain offshore spill response and well containment property used to control pollution.

HB 2467 Murphy | et al.  
Relating to the Texas Economic Development Act; authorizing a fee.

HB 2543 Eiland | et al.  
Relating to changing the manner in which the tax on mixed beverages is imposed.

HB 2684 Button  
Relating to an exemption from the franchise tax for certain political subdivision corporations.

HB 3095 Strama  
Relating to a reduction in the mixed beverage tax for certain venues that present live music; authorizing a fee.

HB 3111 Hilderbran | et al.  
Relating to a tax credit for eligible costs and expenses incurred during the rehabilitation of a historic structure located in a severely damaged or flooded census tract:

HB 3245 Callegari  
Relating to a franchise or insurance premium tax credit for contributions made to certain educational assistance organizations.

HB 3387 Hilderbran  
Relating to an exemption from the sales tax for certified water conservation technologies, authorizing a fee.

HB 3390 Hilderbran  
Relating to the Texas Economic Development Act.

HB 3536 Otto  
Relating to the imposition of a fee on the sale of cigarettes and cigarette tobacco products manufactured by certain companies; providing penalties.

HB 3572 Hilderbran  
Relating to the administration, collection, and enforcement of taxes on the wholesale and retail sale of certain alcoholic beverages; imposing a tax on sales of alcoholic beverages at the wholesale level.

HB 3591 Hilderbran  
Relating to state funding to support economic development; providing for the imposition of a fee.
