Relating to the discharge of a surety's liability on a bail bond in a criminal case.

**SB 965** Williams  
Relating to the correction of employment termination reports for law enforcement officers.

**SB 990** West  
Relating to criminal history record information obtained or disseminated by a private entity; providing a civil penalty; authorizing fees.

**SB 1096** Hinojosa  
Relating to the monthly fee a defendant must pay during a period of community supervision.

**SB 1114** Whitmire | et al.  
Relating to the prosecution of certain misdemeanor offenses committed by children and to school district law enforcement.

**SB 1289** Williams  
Relating to certain business entities engaged in the publication or other dissemination of mug shots and other information regarding the involvement of an individual in the criminal justice system; providing a civil penalty.

**SB 1348** West  
Relating to certain criminal offenses concerning the unlawful transfer or purchase of certain weapons.

**SB 1611** Ellis | et al.  
Relating to discovery in a criminal case.
