A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of a segment of U.S. Highway 75 in
3 Collin County as the Sam Johnson Highway.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 225.091 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 225.091. SAM JOHNSON HIGHWAY. (a) Notwithstanding
8 Section 225.001(c), the portion of U.S. Highway 75 in Collin County
9 between its intersection with the President George Bush Highway and
10 its intersection with U.S. Highway 380 is designated as the Sam
11 Johnson Highway. The designation is in addition to any other
12 designation.

13 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

14 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
15 designation as the Sam Johnson Highway and any other appropriate
16 information; and

17 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
18 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

11 War Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other
12 designation.

13 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

14 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
15 designation as the Prisoner of War Memorial Highway and any other
16 appropriate information; and

17 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
18 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.
