6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2157, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 2157.007 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 2157.007. CONSIDERATION OF CLOUD COMPUTING SERVICE
9	PURCHASE. (a) "Cloud computing service" means a service that
10	provides network access to a shared pool of configurable computing
11	resources on demand, including networks, servers, storage,
12	applications, or related technology services, that may be rapidly
13	provisioned and released by the service provider with minimal
14	effort and interaction. The term does not include
15	telecommunications service or the act of hosting computing
16	resources dedicated to a single purchaser.
17	(b) A state agency must consider cloud computing service
18	options when making purchases for a major information resources
19	project under Section 2054.118.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
