SECTION 1. Chapter 342, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Subchapter Z to read as follows: SUBCHAPTER Z. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS Sec. 342.901. FIRE SUPPRESSION STANDARDS IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This section applies to a general law municipality that: (1) has a population of less than 4,000; (2) is located in a county that: (A) has a population of more than one million; and (B) is adjacent to a county with a population of more than 420,000: and (3) is served by a district governed by Chapter 51, Water Code. (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the governing body of a municipality may by ordinance establish water flow and water pressure standards sufficient to provide adequate pressure to fire suppression systems and require a district described by Subsection (a)(3) that provides water service in the municipality to take reasonable measures to comply with those standards.

(c) To the extent of a conflict between this section and any other law, this section controls.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
