House Bill (HB) 4148, as Filed by Representative Geanie Morrison- Relating to compensation and reimbursement of expenses for the board of directors of the Refugio County Drainage District No. 1

Dear Speaker Straus:

The following comments are provided pursuant to the Constitutional requirements referenced above. Under those requirements, the TCEQ must submit, to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the House of Representatives, the TCEQ's recommendations on specific legislation affecting water districts. We recommend that these comments be considered in the evaluation of the proposed legislation.

The bill repeals previous legislation of the Refugio County Drainage District No. 1 (the "District") related to fees of office for a director and reimbursement of director expenses. Specifically, the legislation being repealed specified that the District's board members could not receive fees of office or actual and necessary travel expenses incurred at amounts greater than \$400 per month for each category.


