1 Amend C.S.H.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) in Article II of the bill immediately following the appropriations to the Health 2 3 and Human Services Commission (page II-73) by adding the following 4 appropriately numbered rider and renumbering subsequent riders 5 accordingly: 6 \_\_\_\_. Contingency for Medicaid Waiver Expiration. In the event 7 the Health and Human Services Commission does not obtain an 8 extension or renewal of the uncompensated care pool provisions of the Texas Health Care Transformation and Quality Improvement 10 Program Waiver issued under Section 1115 of the federal Social 11 Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1315), it is the intent of the 12 legislature that the Health and Human Services Commission shall 13 develop a transition plan to distribute funds allocated above or 14 otherwise make payments using funds allocated above to offset the 15 costs of uncompensated care with the goals of: (1) carving out hospital payments from Medicaid capitation rates paid to Medicaid 16 17 managed care organizations, (2) reimbursing hospital inpatient and 18 outpatient rates under existing Medicaid fee-for-service schedules 19 and rates, and (3) making appropriate modifications to other 20 hospital payments provided under the Texas Health 21 Transformation and Quality Improvement Program Waiver. It is the intent of the legislature that the Health and Human Services 22 23 Commission report the transition plan to the governor and the 24 Legislative Budget Board and adopt rules necessary for implementing 25 the transition plan, implementing the hospital carve out described above, restoring federal supplemental payments to hospitals, and 26 27 maintaining the pay-for-performance and quality incentives of the current managed care delivery system. 28
