- 8 shall impose the following fees:
- 9 (1) for filing a certificate of formation or an
- 10 application for registration as a foreign professional
- 11 association, \$750; and
- 12 (2) [for filing an annual statement, \$35; and
- 13  $\left[\frac{3}{3}\right]$  for filing any other instrument, the fee
- 14 provided for the filing of a similar instrument under Section
- 15 4.152.

- 19 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 302.012, Business Organizations
- 20 Code, is repealed.
- 21 SECTION \_\_\_\_. (a) Section 153.301, Business Organizations
- 22 Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a report required to
- 23 be filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A report
- 24 required to be filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 25 governed by the law in effect on the date the report is due, and the
- 26 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 (b) Section 4.156, Business Organizations Code, as amended
- 28 by this Act, and Section 302.012, Business Organizations Code, as
- 29 repealed by this Act, apply only to an annual statement required to

- 1 be filed on or after the effective date of this Act. An annual
- 2 statement required to be filed before the effective date of this Act
- 3 is governed by the law in effect on the date the statement is due,
- 4 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION \_\_\_\_. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
- 6 (4) Renumber the SECTIONS of the bill appropriately.
