- Amend H.B. No. 3453 (house committee printing) by striking
- 2 all below the enacting clause and substituting following:
- 3 SECTION 1. INTERIM COMMITTEE; STUDY. (a) A joint interim
- 4 committee on TRS ActiveCare is established to study:
- 5 (1) the impact of allowing school districts and other
- 6 participating entities in the uniform group coverage program for
- 7 active employees under Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, to opt out
- 8 of that program;
- 9 (2) the impact, should participating entities be
- 10 authorized to opt out of the program, of allowing or prohibiting
- 11 future participation by previous participating entities that
- 12 have opted out; and
- 13 (3) the impact of establishing a regional rating
- 14 method for determining premiums charged in different regions of
- 15 the state for the benefits provided under a group coverage plan
- 16 established under the program.
- 17 (b) The joint interim committee shall be composed of six
- 18 senators appointed by the lieutenant governor and six members of
- 19 the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the
- 20 house of representatives.
- 21 (c) The lieutenant governor and speaker of the house of
- 22 representatives shall each designate a co-chair from among the
- 23 joint interim committee members.
- 24 (d) The joint interim committee shall convene at the joint
- 25 call of the co-chairs.
- 26 (e) The joint interim committee has all other powers and
- 27 duties provided to a special or select committee by the rules of
- 28 the senate and house of representatives, by Subchapter B,
- 29 Chapter 301, Government Code, and by policies of the senate and

- 1 house committees on administration.
- 2 (f) Not later than January 1, 2017, the joint interim
- 3 committee shall report the committee's findings and
- 4 recommendations to the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the
- 5 house of representatives, the governor, the Teacher Retirement
- 6 System of Texas, and each house and senate standing committee
- 7 with primary jurisdiction over primary and secondary education
- 8 or health benefit plan coverage.
- 9 (g) From the contingent expense fund of the senate and the
- 10 contingent expense fund of the house of representatives equally,
- 11 the members of the joint interim committee shall be reimbursed
- 12 for expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of this Act
- 13 in accordance with the senate and house of representatives rules
- 14 of procedure and the policies of the committees on
- 15 administration. Other necessary expenses of operation shall be
- 16 paid from the contingent expense fund of the senate and the
- 17 contingent expense fund of the house of representatives equally.
- 18 SECTION 2. ABOLITION OF COMMITTEE. The joint interim
- 19 committee on TRS ActiveCare created by this Act is abolished and
- 20 this Act expires September 1, 2017.
- 21 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 22 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the
- 23 members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39,
- 24 Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive
- 25 the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect
- 26 September 1, 2015.
