

FLOOR AMENDMENT NO.

Amend SB 200 as follows:

- Add the appropriately numbered section below and renumber subsequent sections accordingly.
- 3 SECTION __. (a) The Health and Human Services Commission
- 4 shall develop a strategic plan to significantly reduce morbidity
- 5 and mortality from chronic respiratory disease, including asthma
- 6 and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.
- 7 (b) In developing the strategic plan, the Health and Human
- 8 Services Commission shall collaborate with the Department of
- 9 State Health Services, including the Chronic Disease Prevention
- 10 Division and may convene any necessary workgroups. The members
- 11 of a workgroup may include health care providers, medical school
- 12 and academic experts, nonprofit and community organizations, and
- 13 other people the department determines necessary specializing in
- 14 asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease prevention,
- 15 screening, treatment, or research.
- 16 (c) In developing the strategic plan, the Health and Human
- 17 Service Commission shall:
- 18 (1) identify barriers to effective prevention,
- 19 screening, medication adherence, and treatment for asthma and
- 20 chronic obstructive pulmonary disease;
- 21 (2) identify methods to increase awareness of the
- 22 risk factors and symptoms associated with asthma and chronic
- 23 obstructive pulmonary disease;
- 24 (3) identify methods to increase the use of regular
- 25 evidence-based screening for asthma and chronic obstructive
- 26 pulmonary disease;
- 27 (4) review current technologies and best practices
- 28 for chronic respiratory disease diagnosis, management and
- 29 treatment;

- 1 (5) develop methods for creating partnerships with
- 2 public and private entities to increase awareness of asthma and
- 3 chronic obstructive pulmonary disease;
- 4 (6) review current prevention, screening, treatment,
- 5 and other related activities in this state for asthma and
- 6 chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and identify areas in
- 7 which the health care services provided through those activities
- 8 are lacking;
- 9 (7) estimate the annual direct and indirect state
- 10 health care costs attributable to asthma and chronic obstructive
- 11 pulmonary disease; and
- 12 (8) make recommendations to the legislature on state
- 13 policy changes and funding needed to implement the strategic
- 14 plan.
- 15 (d) Not later than December 31, 2016, the Department of
- 16 State Health Services shall deliver to the governor and members
- 17 of the legislature the strategic plan and recommendations on
- 18 goal implementation and schedule compliance related to the
- 19 strategic plan developed as required by this section.
- 20 (e) This section expires January 1, 2017.
