- 10 25.0007(c), in [In]" and substitute "In".
- 11 (5) On page 3, line 4, strike "and with the consent of the
- 12 judge" and substitute "[and with the consent of the judge]".

- 14 subsequent SECTIONS of the bill.

- 11 composed of 12 members.

- 16 shall be composed of six members. Juries in family law cases and
- 17 proceedings shall be composed of 12 members, unless the parties
- 18 agree to a six-member jury.
- 19 SECTION ____. Section 25.1732(1), Government Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (1) A jury in a county court at law is composed of six
- 22 persons unless the constitution or other law requires the jury to be
- 23 composed of 12 members.
- 24 SECTION ____. Section 25.1802(o), Government Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (o) If a jury trial is requested in a case that is in a
- 27 county court at law's jurisdiction, the jury shall be composed of
- 28 six members unless the constitution or other law requires a
- 29 12-member jury. Failure to object before a six-member jury is
- 30 seated and sworn constitutes a waiver of a 12-member jury. To the

- 20 by the vote of any number of jurors less than all those hearing the
- 21 case.
