## **AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT**

C.S.H.B. 583 amends current law relating to donations to certain local veteran's charities ordered as a condition of community supervision.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

- SECTION 1. Amends Section 16, Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, by amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (h), as follows:
  - (f) Authorizes a judge, in lieu of requiring a defendant to work a specified number of hours at a community service project or projects under Subsection (a) (authorizing a judge to require as a condition of community supervision that the defendant work a specified number of hours at a community service project or projects for a certain organization or organizations) to order a defendant to make a specified donation to:
    - (1) a nonprofit food bank or food pantry in the community in which the defendant resides;
    - (2) a charitable organization engaged primarily in performing charitable functions for veterans in the community in which the defendant resides; or
    - (3) in a county with a population of less than 50,000, another nonprofit organization that:
      - (A) is exempt from taxation under Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 because it is listed in Section 501(c)(3) of that code; and
      - (B) provides services or assistance to needy individuals and families in the community in which the defendant resides.
  - (h) Defines "charitable organization" and "veteran" in this section.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2015.
