## **AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT**

As proposed, S.B. 1959 amends current law relating to peace officers commissioned by the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, to add officers commissioned by the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners under Section 801.164, Occupations Code, to a list of individuals designated as peace officers.

SECTION 2. Amends Subchapter D, Chapter 801, Occupations Code, by adding Section 801.164, as follows:

Sec. 801.164. PEACE OFFICERS. (a) Authorizes the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners to commission as a peace officer to enforce this chapter an employee who has been certified as qualified to be a peace officer by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

(b) Provides that an employee commissioned as a peace officer under this chapter has the powers, privileges, and immunities of a peace officer while carrying out duties as a peace officer under this chapter.

SECTION 3. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2015.
