- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 39.054, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsections (d-2) and (d-3) to read as follows:
- 8 (d-2) Except as provided by Subsection (d-3), in evaluating
- 9 performance under Subsection (c), the commissioner may not lower a
- 10 performance rating for purposes of this chapter based on
- 11 unsatisfactory performance on an assessment instrument
- 12 administered under Section 39.023(a), (b), (c), (l), or (n) to a
- 13 student for a period of two years after the student's initial
- 14 enrollment in a school in the United States if the student is a
- 15 student of limited English proficiency, as defined by Section
- 16 29.052. This subsection does not apply to a performance rating for
- 17 purposes of:

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- 18 (1) compliance monitoring under Section 7.028; or
- 19 (2) public school accountability under federal law.
- 20 <u>(d-3)</u> Subsection (d-2) does not apply if the assessment
- 21 instrument administered to a student of limited English proficiency
- 22 is in the student's native language.
- SECTION 2. Section 39.305(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 24 read as follows:

- 1 (b) The report card shall include the following
- 2 information:
- 3 (1) where applicable, the student achievement
- 4 indicators described by Section 39.053(c) and the reporting
- 5 indicators described by Sections 39.301(c)(1) through (5);
- 6 (2) average class size by grade level and subject;
- 7 (3) the administrative and instructional costs per
- 8 student, computed in a manner consistent with Section 44.0071;
- 9 [and]
- 10 (4) the district's instructional expenditures ratio
- 11 and instructional employees ratio computed under Section 44.0071,
- 12 and the statewide average of those ratios, as determined by the
- 13 commissioner; and
- 14 (5) the performance of students of limited English
- 15 proficiency, as defined by Section 29.052, on assessment
- 16 <u>instruments administered under Section 39.023</u>.
- SECTION 3. Section 39.054(d-2), Education Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, applies to a student regardless of the date on which the
- 19 student initially enrolled in a school in the United States.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
