6	SECTION 1. Section 39.054, Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsections (d-2) and (d-3) to read as follows:
8	(d-2) Except as provided by Subsection (d-3), in evaluating
9	performance under Subsection (c), the commissioner may not lower a
10	performance rating for purposes of this chapter based on
11	unsatisfactory performance on an assessment instrument
12	administered under Section 39.023(a), (b), (c), (l), or (n) to a
13	student for a period of three years after the student's initial
14	enrollment in a school in the United States if the student is a
15	student of limited English proficiency, as defined by Section
16	29.052. Unless a student is enrolled in a school in the United
17	States for a period of at least 60 consecutive days during a year,
18	the student may not be considered to be enrolled in a school in the
19	United States for that year for purposes of this subsection. This
20	subsection does not apply to a performance rating for purposes of:
21	(1) compliance monitoring under Section 7.028; or
22	(2) public school accountability under federal law.
23	(d-3) Subsection (d-2) does not apply if the assessment
24	instrument administered to a student of limited English proficiency

- 3 this Act, applies to a student regardless of the date on which the
- 4 student initially enrolled in a school in the United States.
