## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to academic assessment of public school students with

3 significant disabilities.

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by

6 adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows:

7 (b-2) In addition to assessment instruments redeveloped as

8 provided by Subsection (b-1), the agency, in conjunction with

appropriate interested persons, shall develop, in a manner

10 consistent with federal law, alternative methods for assessing

11 significantly cognitively disabled students and medically fragile

12 students in a special education program under Subchapter A, Chapter

13 29, for whom an assessment instrument under Subsection (b) or (b-1)

14 would not provide an appropriate measure of student achievement, as

15 determined by the student's admission, review, and dismissal

16 committee. An alternative method for assessing students under this

17 subsection may include, to the extent consistent with federal law,

18 portfolio assessment to evaluate student learning through a series

19 of student-produced work aligned to curriculum categories. The

20 commissioner by rule shall adopt procedures as necessary to enable

21 the administration of assessments developed under this subsection.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
