5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 435, Health and Safety

- Code, is amended by adding Sections 435.0061, 435.0062, and 6
- 435.0063 to read as follows: 7
- Sec. 435.0061. RAW MILK AND RAW MILK PRODUCTS FOR RETAIL 8
- 9 SALE. (a) This section does not authorize the sale of:
- (1) raw milk or raw milk products to or on the premises 10
- of a grocery store, supermarket, or similar retail market; 11
- 12 (2) raw milk or raw milk products that are a blend of
- raw milk purchased from more than one holder of a permit issued 13
- 14 under this chapter; or
- (3) raw milk or raw milk products by a person other 15

- (b) Except as provided by Section 435.013, a person who 17
- holds a permit that authorizes the person to sell raw milk or raw 18

- 2 (d) A person who sells raw milk or raw milk products under

- 19 <u>Sec. 435.0063.</u> STORING, HANDLING, AND TRANSPORTING RAW MILK
- 20 AND RAW MILK PRODUCTS FOR RETAIL SALE. (a) The executive
- 21 commissioner shall adopt rules for the safe storing, handling, and
- 22 transporting of raw milk and raw milk products produced for sale
- 23 <u>under Section 435.0061.</u>
- (b) Raw milk and raw milk products produced for retail sale
- 25 under this chapter must be placed in a sterile or single-use
- 26 container and sold not later than the fifth day after the date the
- 27 <u>container was filled</u>.

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- 1 (c) Raw milk and raw milk products being transported for
- 2 delivery must be:
- 3 <u>(1) maintained in air temperatures at or below 45</u>
- 4 degrees Fahrenheit at all times except during transfer from one
- 5 storage area or transportation vehicle to another; and
- 6 (2) protected from exposure to direct sunlight.
- 7 (d) The department or a local health authority may not
- 8 mandate the specific method for complying with a temperature
- 9 requirement.
- 10 (e) A producer may contract with another person to transport
- 11 and deliver raw milk and raw milk products in accordance with this
- 12 section. The producer is jointly and severally liable for
- 13 transport and delivery of raw milk and raw milk products not
- 14 conducted in accordance with this chapter and department rules.
