## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of certain volunteer firefighter and emergency services organizations to hold tax-free sales or 3 auctions. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 151.310, Tax Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows: 7 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), an organization that 8 qualifies for an exemption under Subsection (a)(4) may hold 10 9 tax-free sales or auctions during a calendar year. Each tax-free 10 sale or auction may continue for not more than 72 hours. The 11 storage, use, or consumption of a taxable item that is acquired from 12 a qualified organization at a tax-free sale or auction and that is 13 14 exempted under this subsection from the taxes imposed by Subchapter C is exempted from the use tax imposed by Subchapter D until the 15 item is resold or subsequently transferred. If an organization 16 that qualifies for an exemption under Subsection (a)(4) jointly 17 holds a tax-free sale or auction with one or more other exempt 18 organizations, the tax-free sale or auction is considered to be one 19 of the organization's 10 tax-free sales or auctions authorized by 20 this subsection during that calendar year. 21

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not 22 23 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been 24

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1 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the 2 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of 3 the liability for those taxes.

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4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
