Sec. 56.502. EXEMPTION. An institution of higher education 17 shall exempt an eligible person from the payment of tuition and 18 mandatory fees for the semester credit hours for which the person 19 enrolls, not to exceed a total of 120 semester credit hours. If the 20 21 person is not charged tuition at the rate provided for other Texas residents, the amount of the exemption may not exceed the amount of 22

6 SECTION 2. (a) The changes in law made by this Act apply 7 beginning with the 2015 fall semester.

8 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall 9 adopt rules for the administration of Subchapter S, Chapter 56, 10 Education Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after 11 this Act takes effect. For that purpose, the coordinating board may 12 adopt the rules in the manner provided by law for emergency rules.

13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
