- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 109, Alcoholic Beverage
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 109.37 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 109.37. CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NEAR PUBLIC
- 9 TRANSPORTATION STOPS. (a) In this section:
- 10 (1) "Open container" has the meaning assigned by
- 11 Section 109.35.
- 12 (2) "Public transportation passenger vehicle" means a
- 13 <u>vehicle operated by a political subdivision and used for the</u>
- 14 transportation of passengers for a fee.
- (b) The commissioners court of a county may enact
- 16 regulations applicable in areas in the county outside an
- 17 incorporated city or town, and the governing board of an
- 18 incorporated city or town may enact regulations applicable in the
- 19 city or town, prohibiting the possession of an open container or the
- 20 consumption of an alcoholic beverage on a public street, public
- 21 alley, or public sidewalk within 300 feet of the property line of a
- 22 station, platform, bus stop, bus shelter, or other place designated
- 23 as a place of entry to or exit from a public transportation
- 24 passenger vehicle.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
