- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1332.001, Government Code, is amended to

- 7 Sec. 1332.001. USE OF UNSPENT BOND PROCEEDS FOR OTHER
- 8 PURPOSES. (a) The governing body of a municipality other than a
- 9 home-rule municipality may use the proceeds of municipal bonds that
- 10 have been sold and delivered for a specific purpose for a purpose
- 11 other than the specific purpose if:
- 12 (1) the specific purpose is accomplished by other
- 13 means or is abandoned;
- 14 (2) the proceeds are unspent; and
- 15 (3) a majority of the votes cast in an election held in
- 16 the municipality approve the use of the proceeds for the proposed
- 17 purpose.
- 18 (b) The governing body of a home-rule municipality may use
- 19 the unspent proceeds of municipal bonds that have been sold and
- 20 delivered for a specific purpose only for the specific purpose,
- 21 including retiring the outstanding bonds.
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to municipal bonds authorized after the effective date of this Act.
- 24 Municipal bonds authorized before the effective date of this Act

H.B. No. 156

- 1 are governed by the law in effect on the date the bonds were
- 2 authorized, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 3 purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
