## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to interstate cooperation to address regional water
- 3 issues.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 8, Water Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 8. SOUTHWESTERN STATES WATER [MULTI-STATE WATER RESOURCES
- 8 PLANNING COMMISSION
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 8.001(1), Water Code, is amended to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 (1) "Commission" means the Southwestern States Water
- 12 [Multi-State Water Resources Planning] Commission.
- SECTION 3. Section 8.011, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- Sec. 8.011. CREATION OF COMMISSION. The Southwestern
- 16 States Water [Multi-State Water Resources Planning] Commission is
- 17 created as an advisory commission to the governor and the
- 18 <u>legislature</u> [agency of the state].
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 8.013, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 Sec. 8.013. COMMISSIONERS [MEMBERS OF COMMISSION];
- 22 APPOINTMENT.  $[\frac{a}{a}]$  The commission is composed of  $\underline{six}$  [seven]
- 23 commissioners. Two commissioners [who] are appointed by the
- 24 governor, two commissioners are appointed by the lieutenant

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- 1 governor, and two commissioners are appointed by the speaker of the
- 2 house of representatives [with the advice and consent of the
- 3 senate].
- 4 [(b) The governor shall make the appointments so that each
- 5 member is from a different section of the state.
- 6 [<del>(c) Three commissioners must be members of the general</del>
- 7 public, one commissioner must have a background in the field of
- 8 higher education, one commissioner must have a background in
- 9 private business, one commissioner must have a background in
- 10 agriculture, and one commissioner must have a background in an
- 11 energy-related field.
- 12 SECTION 5. Section 8.015, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 Sec. 8.015. TERMS [OF OFFICE]. (a) Commissioners serve
- 15 [hold office] for staggered terms of six years, with the terms of
- 16 two or three commissioners expiring on February 1 of each
- 17 odd-numbered year.
- 18 (b) Each commissioner serves [holds office] until the
- 19 <u>commissioner's</u> [his] successor is appointed [and has qualified for
- 20 office].
- 21 (c) A [If a] vacancy on the commission [occurs in the office
- 22 of commissioner, the governor] shall be filled [appoint a successor
- 23 to serve] for the unexpired portion of the term in the same manner
- 24 as the original appointment.
- 25 SECTION 6. Section 8.019, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 26 follows:
- Sec. 8.019. ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT [STAFF]. The board

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- 1 shall provide <u>administrative</u> [necessary staff and] support to the
- 2 commission to assist the commission in carrying out this chapter.
- 3 SECTION 7. Section 8.051, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 Sec. 8.051. INTERACTION WITH OTHER STATES. (a) In
- 6 cooperation with representatives of neighboring states, the
- 7 commission <u>may discuss</u> [shall study] the water needs of the region
- 8 [after the year 2000].
- 9 (b) The commission may [shall] initiate and carry out
- 10 discussions with representatives of neighboring states relating to
- 11 the identification and development of sources and methods of
- 12 augmenting water supplies on a regional basis after existing water
- 13 supplies are fully committed.
- SECTION 8. Section 8.052, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 15 follows:
- Sec. 8.052. INTERACTION WITH MEXICO. The commission may
- 17 [shall contract and] confer with the government of Mexico
- 18 concerning water needs and development of sources of water supply.
- 19 SECTION 9. Section 8.056, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- Sec. 8.056. COMPACTS. The commission <u>may</u> [shall] contact
- 22 and negotiate with other states regarding the need for establishing
- 23 interstate compacts, addressing groundwater problems, needs, and
- 24 supplies, if an aquifer underlies several states, and addressing
- 25 other related subjects that would be beneficial to the states
- 26 including the conservation and beneficial use of water.
- 27 SECTION 10. Sections 8.014, 8.018, and 8.053, Water Code,

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- 1 are repealed.
- 2 SECTION 11. (a) Promptly after this Act takes effect, the
- 3 governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of
- 4 representatives shall appoint the initial members of the
- 5 Southwestern States Water Commission under Chapter 8, Water Code,
- 6 as amended by this Act.
- 7 (b) In appointing the initial members of the commission:
- 8 (1) the governor shall appoint one person to a term
- 9 expiring February 1, 2017, and one person to a term expiring
- 10 February 1, 2019;
- 11 (2) the lieutenant governor shall appoint one person
- 12 to a term expiring February 1, 2017, and one person to a term
- 13 expiring February 1, 2021; and
- 14 (3) the speaker of the house of representatives shall
- 15 appoint one person to a term expiring February 1, 2019, and one
- 16 person to a term expiring February 1, 2021.
- 17 SECTION 12. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
