1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to creating a recognition day in honor of Gold Star  
1-19 Mothers.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is  
1-22 amended by adding Section 662.061 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 662.061. GOLD STAR MOTHER'S DAY. (a) The last Sunday  
1-24 in September of each year is Gold Star Mother's Day in recognition  
1-25 of mothers whose sons and daughters died while serving in the United  
1-26 States armed forces.

1-27 (b) Gold Star Mother's Day shall be regularly observed by  
1-28 appropriate ceremonies.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
