- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Chapter 21, Penal Code, is amended by adding 4
- 5 Section 21.16 to read as follows:
- Sec. 21.16. VOYEURISM. (a) A person commits an offense if 6
- 7 the person, with the intent to arouse or gratify the sexual desire
- of the actor, observes another person without the other person's 8
- 9 consent while the other person is in a dwelling or structure in
- which the other person has a reasonable expectation of privacy. 10
- 11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) or (d), an offense
- under this section is a Class C misdemeanor. 12
- (c) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor 13
- if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the actor has 14
- previously been convicted two or more times of an offense under this 15
- 16 section.
- (d) An offense under this section is a state jail felony if 17
- the victim was a child younger than 14 years of age at the time of 18
- the offense. 19
- (e) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this 20
- section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor 21
- may be prosecuted under this section, the other law, or both. 22
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
