6	Sec. 21.16. VOYEURISM. (a) A person commits an offense if
7	the person, with the intent to arouse or gratify the sexual desire
8	of the actor, observes another person without the other person's
9	consent while the other person is in a dwelling or structure in
10	which the other person has a reasonable expectation of privacy.
11	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) or (d), an offense
12	under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
13	(c) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor
14	if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the actor has
15	previously been convicted two or more times of an offense under this
16	section.
17	(d) An offense under this section is a state jail felony if
18	the victim was a child younger than 14 years of age at the time of
19	the offense.
20	(e) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this
21	section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor
22	may be prosecuted under this section, the other law, or both.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
