- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 21, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 5 Section 21.16 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 21.16. VOYEURISM. (a) A person commits an offense if
- 7 the person, with the intent to arouse or gratify the sexual desire
- 8 of the actor, observes another person without the other person's
- 9 consent while the other person is in a dwelling or structure in
- 10 which the other person has a reasonable expectation of privacy.
- 11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) or (d), an offense
- 12 under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- (c) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor
- 14 if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the actor has
- 15 previously been convicted two or more times of an offense under this
- 16 section.
- 17 (d) An offense under this section is a state jail felony if
- 18 the victim was a child younger than 14 years of age at the time of
- 19 the offense.
- 20 <u>(e) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this</u>
- 21 section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor
- 22 may be prosecuted under this section, the other law, or both.
