- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Sections 753.004(d) and (e), Health and Safety 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:

- 7 (d) Gasoline, diesel fuel, or kerosene may be stored in an
- aboveground storage tank [with a capacity of not more than 4,000 8
- gallons] at a retail service station located in an unincorporated 9
- area or in a municipality with a population of less than 5,000. 10
- (e) Under Subsection (d), a retail service station may have 11
- 12 a tank [not exceeding the specified capacity] for each separate
- grade of gasoline, diesel fuel, or kerosene, but may not have more 13
- 14 than one tank [of that capacity] for the same grade.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 19
