(a) If substituted service of citation is authorized under the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, the court, in accordance 10 with the rules adopted by the supreme court under Subsection (b), 11 may prescribe as a method of service an electronic communication 12 sent to the defendant through a social media presence. 13 14 (b) The supreme court shall adopt rules to provide for the substituted service of citation by an electronic communication sent 15 16 to a defendant through a social media presence. SECTION 2. The Supreme Court of Texas shall adopt rules 17 under Section 17.032, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, as added by 18 this Act, not later than December 31, 2015. 19 SECTION 3. Section 17.032, Civil Practice and Remedies 20 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an action commenced on 21 or after the effective date of the rules adopted by the Supreme 22 23 Court of Texas under that section. 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
