## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the lunch period for classroom teachers at the middle
- 3 school, junior high school, or high school grade level.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.405(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), each classroom
- 8 teacher or full-time librarian at the elementary school level is
- 9 entitled to at least a 30-minute lunch period free from all duties
- 10 and responsibilities connected with the instruction and
- 11 supervision of students. Except as provided by Subsection (c),
- 12 each classroom teacher or full-time librarian at the middle school,
- 13 junior high school, or high school grade level is entitled to at
- 14 least a 45-minute lunch period free from all duties and
- 15 responsibilities connected with the instruction and supervision of
- 16 students. Each school district may set flexible or rotating
- 17 schedules for each classroom teacher or full-time librarian in the
- 18 district for the implementation of the duty-free lunch period.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
