Section 42.152, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (c-3) to read as follows: 8 (c-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), funds allocated under 9 this section may be used to: (1) provide child-care services or assistance with 10 child-care expenses for students at risk of dropping out of school, 11 12 as defined by Section 29.081(d)(5); or 13 (2) pay the costs of day care or associated 14 transportation provided through a life skills program in accordance with Sections 29.085(b)(3), (4), and (5). 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 16
