- 11 (1) the progress made in developing needed water
- 12 supply statewide and for the benefit of each regional water

- 14 (2) for each regional water planning area, a
- 15 description of each project funded through bonds supported by a
- 16 bond enhancement agreement entered into under Section 15.435,
- 17 including:
- 18 (A) the expected date of completion of the
- 19 project; [and]
- 20 (B) the current status of the project;
- (C) the amount of bonds issued and the terms of
- 22 the bonds;
- (D) a summary of the terms of the bond
- 24 enhancement agreement;

1	(E) the status of repayment of any loan provided
2	in connection with the project, including an assessment of the risk
3	of default based on a standard risk rating system; and
4	(F) the check register for the project;
5	(3) a description of the investment portfolio of the
6	fund;
7	(4) the expenses incurred in investing money in the
8	fund;
9	(5) the rate of return on the investment of money in
10	the fund;
11	(6) a description of the point system for prioritizing
12	projects established by the board under Section 15.437(b) and the
13	number of points awarded by the board for each project;
14	(7) any nonconfidential information submitted to the
15	board as part of an application for financial assistance under this
16	subchapter that is approved by the board;
17	(8) the administrative and operating expenses
18	incurred by the board in developing the state water plan and
19	providing financial assistance for projects included in the plan;
20	and
21	(9) any other information required by board rule.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
