A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

l AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain prekindergarten programs offered by a school
- 3 district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 29.1551 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.1551. PREKINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS RECEIVING STATE
- 8 FUNDING. (a) A school district that receives Foundation School
- 9 Program funds under Section 29.153 or grant funds under Section
- 10 29.155 for a prekindergarten program must offer an enhanced quality
- 11 prekindergarten program and comply with this section.
- 12 (b) A school district may not enroll more than 22 students
- in a prekindergarten class and must maintain an average ratio of at
- 14 least one teacher or educational aide for each 11 students in
- 15 average daily attendance in prekindergarten classes.
- 16 (c) At least one teacher in each prekindergarten class must
- 17 hold a bachelor's degree and appropriate teacher certification.
- 18 <u>(d) Each teacher in a prekindergarten class must have a</u>
- 19 minimum of nine credit hours of college education courses
- 20 emphasizing early childhood education.
- (e) A school district must select the curriculum for the
- 22 enhanced quality prekindergarten program from the list of curricula
- 23 approved for that purpose by the commissioner.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016

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- 1 school year.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
