- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 544.002, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- follows: 6
- 7 A person may not refuse to insure or provide coverage to
- an individual, refuse to continue to insure or provide coverage to 8
- an individual, limit the amount, extent, or kind of coverage 9
- available for an individual, or charge an individual a rate that is 10
- 11 different from the rate charged to other individuals for the same
- 12 coverage because of the individual's:
- 13 (1) race, color, religion, or national origin;
- 14 (2) age, gender, marital status, or geographic
- location; [<del>or</del>] 15
- 16 (3) disability or partial disability; or
- (4) sexual orientation or gender identity or 17
- expression. 18
- 19 (d) In this section:
- (1) "Gender identity or expression" means a person's 20
- 21 having, or being perceived as having, a gender-related identity,
- appearance, expression, or behavior, whether or not that identity, 22
- 23 appearance, expression, or behavior is different from that
- stereotypically associated with the person's assigned sex at birth. 24

- 1 (2) "Sexual orientation" means actual or perceived
- 2 heterosexuality, homosexuality, or bisexuality.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 544.003(b), Insurance Code, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 (b) A person does not violate Section 544.002(a)(2), [or]
- 6 (3), or (4) if the refusal, limitation, or charge is based on sound
- 7 underwriting or actuarial principles reasonably related to actual
- 8 or anticipated loss experience. For the purposes of this
- 9 subsection, a refusal, limitation, or charge relating to title
- 10 insurance is based on sound actuarial principles if the action is
- 11 based on an examination of title or on closing the transaction.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
