The change in law made by this Act applies to a 14 suit affecting the parent-child relationship that is pending in a trial court on or filed on or after the effective date of this Act. 15

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
