A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a defense to prosecution of the offense of Medicaid 3 fraud.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 35A.02, Penal Code, is amended by adding 6 Subsection (g) to read as follows:

7 (g) It is not a defense to prosecution under this section 8 that the Medicaid program has received or recouped funds 9 representing repayment, wholly or partly, for the fraudulent act or 10 acts that are the basis for the criminal charge for which the 11 defendant is indicted.

12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 13 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 14 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 15 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 16 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 17 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 18 before that date. 19

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
