5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 23.55, Tax Code, is amended by adding
7	Subsections (r) and (s) to read as follows:
8	(r) A property owner is subject to the sanctions provided by
9	Subsection (a) if the property owner, a subsidiary of the property
10	owner, or an affiliate of the property owner, or another person
11	acting in concert with the property owner, subsidiary, or
12	affiliate, or any combination of those persons acting in concert
13	with one another:
14	(1) conveys land that has been appraised as provided
15	by this subchapter to a person, the state, or a political
16	subdivision of the state who changes the use of the land but is not
17	subject to the sanctions provided by Subsection (a) for that
18	action; and
19	(2) on or before the fifth anniversary of that
20	conveyance:
21	(A) regains possession of the land; and
22	(B) uses the land in a way that would have
23	subjected the land to the sanctions provided by Subsection (a) if
24	the change had occurred before the conveyance described by

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## 1 <u>Subdivision (1).</u>

2 (s) For purposes of determining the amount of the sanction
3 provided by Subsection (a), the date of a change in the use of land
4 that results in imposition of the sanction is the date of the
5 conveyance described by Subsection (r)(1).

6 SECTION 2. Sections 23.55(r) and (s), Tax Code, as added by 7 this Act, apply to a change of use of land that occurs on or after 8 the effective date of this Act. A change of use of land that 9 occurred before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 10 law in effect when the change of use occurred, and the former law is 11 continued in effect for that purpose.

12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
