A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to authorizing an optional county fee for vehicle
- 3 registration to fund certain transportation projects.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 502.4015 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 502.4015. OPTIONAL COUNTY FEE FOR CERTAIN
- 8 TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS. (a) In addition to any other fee
- 9 authorized under this chapter, the commissioners court of a county
- 10 by order may impose an additional fee, not to exceed \$10, for
- 11 registering a vehicle in the county.
- 12 (b) A vehicle that may be registered under this chapter
- 13 without payment of a registration fee may be registered in a county
- 14 imposing a fee under this section without payment of the additional
- 15 fee.
- 16 (c) A fee imposed under this section may take effect and be
- 17 removed in accordance with the provisions of Section 502.401.
- 18 (d) The county assessor-collector of a county imposing a fee
- 19 under this section shall collect the additional fee for a vehicle
- 20 when other fees imposed under this chapter are collected. The
- 21 county may use the fee revenue only to fund a nontolled
- 22 transportation project that:
- 23 (1) relieves congestion;
- 24 (2) improves safety; or

- 1 (3) addresses air quality.
- 2 (e) The department shall collect the additional fee on a
- 3 vehicle that is owned by a resident of a county imposing a fee under
- 4 this section and that, under this chapter, must be registered
- 5 directly with the department. The department shall send all fees
- 6 collected for a county under this subsection to the county
- 7 treasurer for use as provided by Subsection (d).
- 8 (f) The board shall adopt rules and develop forms necessary
- 9 to administer registration by mail for a vehicle being registered
- 10 in a county imposing a fee under this section.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
