Section 25.027, Tax Code, is amended to read as 5 follows: 6 7 Sec. 25.027. <u>RESTRICTION ON POSTING</u> INFORMATION <u>ON INTERNET</u> [REGARDING CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY]. WEBSITE 8 9 (a) Information in appraisal records may not be posted on the Internet if the information: 10 11 (1) is a photograph, sketch, or floor plan of an 12 improvement to real property that is designed primarily for use as a 13 human residence; or 14 (2) indicates the age of a property owner, including information indicating that a property owner is 65 years of age or 15 16 older. Subsection (a)(1) [This section] does not apply to an 17 (b) aerial photograph that depicts five or more separately owned 18 19 buildings. SECTION 2. Not later than the effective date of this Act, 20 21 the chief appraiser for each appraisal district shall ensure that information described by Section 25.027(a)(2), Tax Code, as added 22 23 by this Act, that is posted on an Internet website controlled by the appraisal district is removed from the website. 24

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
