23	described by Section 171.081 to complete within a reasonable time		
24	after beginning work at the facility a training program to identify

- 2 (b) A training program under this section must use the
- 3 standardized curriculum created by the human trafficking
- 4 prevention task force under Section 402.035(d)(6), Government
- 5 Code.
- 6 (c) The department shall make available to each facility
- 7 described by Sections 171.081(1)(A) and (B) the training program
- 8 required under this section.
- 9 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2015, the executive
- 10 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 11 adopt the rules required by Section 171.082, Health and Safety
- 12 Code, as added by this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. A person described by Section 171.081, Health
- 14 and Safety Code, as added by this Act, who is hired, begins
- 15 volunteering, or begins providing services under contract before
- 16 September 1, 2015, is not required to comply with Section 171.082,
- 17 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, before September 1,
- 18 2016.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
