- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 63, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 63.0091 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 63.0091. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE; VOTING
- 8 PROCEDURES. (a) This section applies to the conduct of voting and
- 9 to the registration of voters notwithstanding and in addition to
- 10 other applicable provisions of this code.
- 11 (b) A person who would be eligible to vote in an election
- 12 under Section 11.001, but for the requirement to be a registered
- 13 voter, shall be accepted for voting in the precinct of the person's
- 14 residence if, on the day the person offers to vote, the person:
- 15 (1) submits a voter registration application that
- 16 complies with Section 13.002; and
- 17 (2) presents proof of identification in one of the
- 18 <u>following forms:</u>

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- (A) a driver's license, license to carry a
- 20 concealed handgun, or personal identification card issued to the
- 21 person by the Department of Public Safety, regardless of whether
- 22 the license or card has expired;
- 23 (B) official mail addressed to the person by name
- 24 from a governmental entity;

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- 1 (C) a copy of a current utility bill, bank
- 2 statement, government check, paycheck, or other government
- 3 document that shows the name and address of the voter; or
- 4 (D) any other form of identification prescribed
- 5 by the secretary of state that establishes the person's residence.
- 6 (c) Persons voting under this section shall be processed
- 7 separately at the polling place from persons who are voting under
- 8 regular procedures.
- 9 (d) The secretary of state shall prescribe the procedures
- 10 necessary to implement this section and to ensure the proper and
- 11 orderly conduct of elections.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
