(b) A person who violates this section commits an offense. 15 16 An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor. 17 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 305, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 305.029 to read as follows: 18 Sec. 305.029. EXPENDITURES FROM POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS 19 RESTRICTED. (a) In this section, "political contribution" has the 20 meaning assigned by Section 251.001, Election Code. 21 22 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person 23 required to register under this chapter may not, before the second anniversary of the date the last term for which the person was 24
