Sections 455.004(b) 4 and (c), Transportation 5 Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 The members of the committee shall be appointed by the 7 governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives, who shall each appoint: 8 (1) one member who represents a diverse cross-section 9 of public transportation providers and may be employed by a transit 10 11 provider or organization representing transit providers; (2) one member who represents a diverse cross-section 12 13 of transportation users and may not be employed by a transit 14 provider or organization representing transit providers; and 15 (3) one member who represents the general public and 16 who may be on the staff of a metropolitan planning organization or rural transportation planning organization but may not be employed 17 by a transit provider or organization representing transit 18 19 providers. Members serve for staggered terms of six years, with the 20 21 terms of three members expiring on February 1 of each odd-numbered

year. A vacancy on the committee shall be filled in the same manner

as the original appointment for that position [A member serves at

the pleasure of the officer who appointed the member]. A member is

- 4 SECTION 2. (a) The terms of the public transportation
- 5 advisory committee members serving on the effective date of this

- 7 (b) The changes in law made by this Act to Section

- 9 public transportation advisory committee with a term beginning on
- 10 or after the effective date of this Act. A member of the public
- 11 transportation advisory committee with a term beginning before the
- 12 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 13 immediately before that date, and the former law is continued in
- 14 effect for that purpose.
- 15 (c) Notwithstanding the changes in law made by this Act, a
- 16 member of the public transportation advisory committee with a term
- 17 beginning before the effective date of this Act may be reappointed
- 18 to the committee under Section 455.004, Transportation Code.
- 19 (d) The governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the
- 20 house of representatives each shall appoint three members to the
- 21 committee, in accordance with Section 455.004, Transportation
- 22 Code, as amended by this Act, for terms beginning February 1, 2017,
- 23 with one member having a term expiring February 1, 2019, one member
- 24 having a term expiring February 1, 2021, and one member having a
- 25 term expiring February 1, 2023.
- 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
